

## Money Maker Stage Size

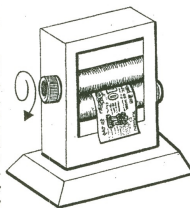


### Magic Note Printing Machine



The *Note Printing Machine* is very popular because it fulfills a basic fantasy. If one could do real Magic, the first thing one would do is mint money, or transform blank paper to currency bills. This apparatus allows you to produce this effect.

Performer displays a frame with two rollers. A sheet of paper is fed between the rollers and the rollers turned, and the paper emerges printed as a genuine currency note which can be examined and even used. (Obviously this trick does not really print currency notes, but just exchanges the blank paper for the currency notes previously concealed inside.)



**The Apparatus :** This comprises of a frame with two rollers. There is a knob on each of the rollers to allow you to turn them. Your view of the frame (from the back, - the illustration shows the audience view) will have the knob for the upper roller to your right, and for the lower roller to your left.

The two rollers have a long sleeve running over them. If you turn the knob on top in a clock wise direction, (turn the knob away from you), both rollers will move together. If you turn it anticlockwise (towards yourself), the bottom roller will not move and the sleeve will simply unwind from the upper roller. Similarly, the bottom knob is turned anticlockwise, (away from you) for the apparatus to operate correctly.

There are two rubber bands on either side of the frame, linking the two rollers together, which prevent the rollers from accidentally unwinding. When required, replace these bands, twisting them into an "S" between the two rollers, as originally supplied. The bands

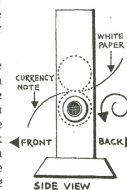
run in the slots on the shafts.

**Set-up :** Presume you want to print two currency notes of two different denominations. You need to first load these between the rollers.

Give the bottom roller several turns so that most of the sleeve is on the bottom roller. Now place one of the currency notes between the two rollers from the front and turn the top roller. The note will vanish between the two rollers. After it has vanished give the top roller an additional turn, then load in the second currency note in an identical manner. Your apparatus is now set.

**In performance,** you require two blank pieces of paper the same size as the currency notes.

Let someone examine the paper if you wish. Feed in one piece (same size as the second loaded note) between the two rollers from the back of the frame. Now turn the bottom roller, and the note seems to emerge in front from between the rollers, creating a perfect illusion of the blank paper getting printed in to a currency note. Repeat this with the second piece of paper to produce the second note.



Practice the handling so that you know how much to turn each roller for a perfect illusion. The sleeve will permit you to produce (or print) even four or five notes if you wish. However, a maximum of three, starting with a low denomination note and finishing with the largest denomination available would be just right.

Obviously since the notes printed are all genuine they can be handed over for the most detailed examination.
