Tabootwo

Preparation: Replace your own red backed Bicycle two of clubs with the one supplied, which is marked on its back at the very centre – the central white dot has been inked in. Stack your deck: JC, QC, KC, 2H, 2C, 2S, 7D, 8D, 9S, rest of deck. Table the cased deck, with the leather covered pad of paper supplied (prediction side down) and a pen.

Performance: Perform any false or semi-false shuffle that retains the upper nine cards, then deal three cards face down in a tabled row from left to right, then another row of three on top of the first, followed by a final row of three on top of those. The rest of the cards are cased and pocketed, as they will not be used.

Ask someone, as you avert your eyes, to pick up

up.

Next, ask the spectator to tell you the suit of his card, but continue that he may either tell the truth or lie. Let's assume he says it is a club. Deal four cards from the top of the face down packet onto the table spelling c-l-u-b (a card for each letter). Drop the rest of the cards in your hand on top of the tabled cards and pick them all up.

Finally, Ask the spectator if his answers have been true, lies or both.

Regardless of his answer, deal four cards from the top of the face down packet onto the table spelling *either* t-r-u-e, l-i-e-s or b-o-t-h (a card for each letter). Drop the rest of the cards in your hand on top of the tabled cards and leave them
