Bob passed this along at Keith Walker's Close Encounters Convention in Rochester this past November and took us completely by surprise. There is some one-time prep routine that we've never seen.

You will need a brass cotter pin from it), a deck of midget cards, a Diamonds. First of all, remove the widthwise. Throw one half away. Make which you have kept. Corner short beneath the Three of Diamonds. Place one of the half-cards aside.

Drill a hole through the inner left corner of the face-down half deck so the prongs of the cotter pin will slide easily through. Cut a notch large enough for the button-end of the cotter pin to fit in in about the top ten cards of the half deck. Slide the cotter pin through the drilled hole so the button rests in the cutout notch and open the prongs so the cards will be held together (firmly, but not too tightly). Take that half card you placed aside before you began drilling and glue it to the back of the gimmick to hide the notch and cotter pin (fig. 1). That's it.
