The SUPER BRAINBUSTER DECK

EFFECT:

A spectator is invited to name any card in a deck. When he does so, the performer removed a deck of cards from his pocket, which when spread out reveals that there is one card and one card only face up in a face down deck. That card is the card named by the spectator.
During the revelation, both sides of the deck are seen to be ordinary backs and fronts.

METHOD:

Two special decks are used to accomplish this stunning effect. Examine one of them and you will see that it consists of pairs of cards which have been treated with a roughing fluid which makes them cling together. The rear card of each pair is a normal playing card, but the front card is printed the same both sides.

One deck of cards has all ODD CARDS, and the other deck has all EVEN CARDS at the face. To show a card face up in a face down deck, proceed as follows:

We will assume the named card is the Seven of Hearts. Take the deck with the ODD CARDS and spread it between both hands with the backs of the cards to the floor. When you see the Seven of Hearts, raise the hands and the deck up to show the backs of the cards to the spectators, and as you do so, separate the Seven of Hearts from the card behind it.

The spectators will now see the other side of the Seven of Hearts showing in the middle of the backs of the cards they are now looking at. Hold the deck in the left hand, backs out, with the reversed (?) Seven of Hearts showing.

Lift the Seven of Hearts up and out of the deck with the right hand. The left hand now turns the deck around so the spectators can see the faces of the deck. The right hand replaces the Seven of Hearts back into the centre of the deck.

As you perform the above actions, make sure that they don't get a glimpse of the other side of the Seven of Hearts. Once the Seven of Hearts is back in the centre of the deck, close the deck up, turn it back out and replace it in the card case.

Don't forget to replace the Seven of Hearts in it's correct position, the right way around, before your next performance.
