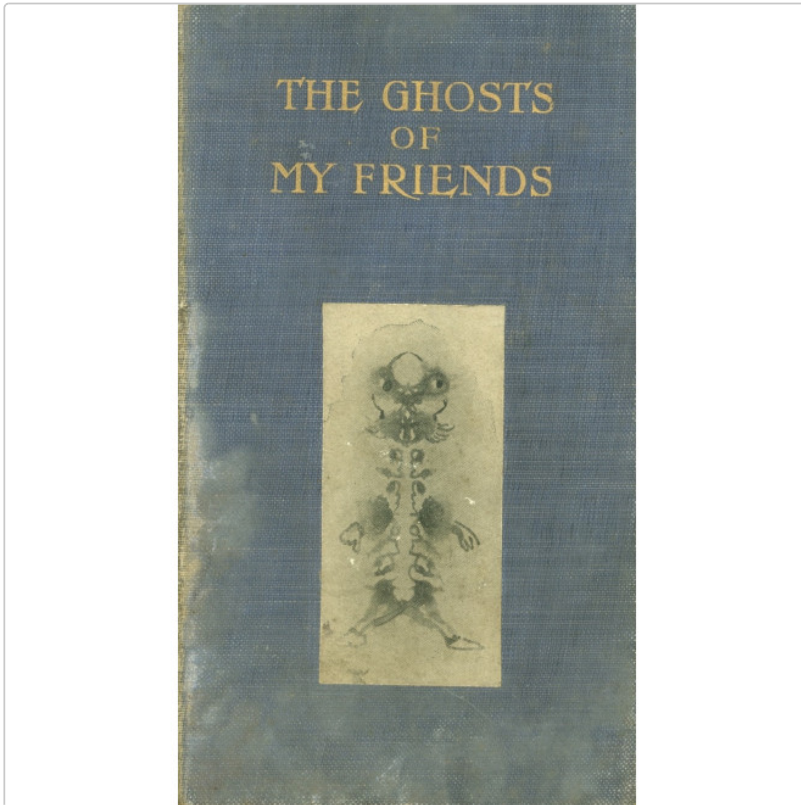


The Ghosts of My Friends
